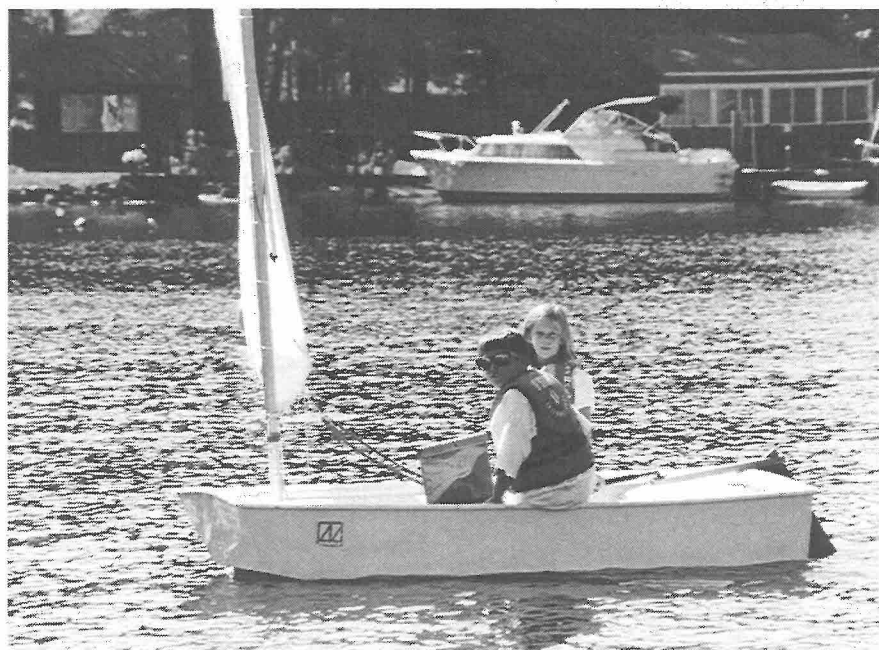
Commodore's Corner
