The LAKE WINNIPESAUKEE SAILING ASSOCIATION (LWSA), cordially invites you to participate in our 15th Annual Regatta, a three week series of Sunday afternoon racing. If you have never participated in a regatta before, this is the one to try.

Early registration is requested (there is an additional fee of \$10.00 after 8/16). Final registration will close at 5:30PM on Saturday 8/21. The Skippers' Meeting will be held at 5:30PM Saturday evening, August 21st at Fay's Boat Yard in Gilford. There will be multiple classes subdivided into racing classes that can use spinnakers and cruising classes that are limited to flying headsails. The number of classes will be determined by the spread of the PHRF ratings of the registrants. J80 Fleet 1 will race as a one design class within the racing class.

The racing on each of three consecutive Sundays will include up to three windward-leeward races as conditions permit for the Racing Classes. Cruising Classes will be sent on island courses as conditions warrant. There will be no skipper's meetings on following Sundays. Boats need only to show up out on the water for the first warning signal at 1:00 PM.

All boats will be rated using the PHRF handicap

system. If you don't have a rating certificate, please call (603) 899-6179 weeknights to request a temporary PHRF rating. The PHRF Handicapper will issue a temporary certificate just for this event. Entry is limited to sailing vessels 20 feet or longer. We will be sailing under USSA Rules and LWSA Sailing Instructions (copies will be available at the Skippers' Meeting or download from the LWSA website at www.lwsa.org). We suggest that you have a copy on board. You are, of course, required to have the normal safety equipment on hand.

On Sunday evening, September 5th, following the racing, there will be a social and awards ceremony at a to be announced location.

An Official Entry Form is included with this invitation letter. Please fill it out and return it at your earliest opportunity to the LWSA at the address indicated.

OFFICIAL NOTICE OF RACE

- 1. **RULES**: The race will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (2001 2004), the prescriptions of US Sailing, the rules of PHRF New England, the LWSA/WYC Combined Sailing Instruction for the 2004 season, and any other applicable rules.
- ELIGIBILITY: Any sailboat over 20 feet may participate. Boats that do not have a current PHRF certificate may compete by obtaining a temporary certificate. Such boats are advised to pre-register to allow sufficient time for accurate handicapping.
- 3. **ENTRY & FEES**: Boats must register by submitting a completed Official Entry Form along with a check made out in the appropriate amount payable to LWSA. Pre-registration should be postmarked no later than August 16, 2004 and mailed to LWSA, PO Box 7047, Gilford, NH 03247. The early registration fee is \$25 (\$20 for USSA members). There is an additional fee of \$10 for entries received on August 21st at registration.
- CLASSES: Boats must register to compete in the PHRF Racing, PHRF Cruising, or J80 One Design Division. Cruising Division may not use spinnakers. The divisions may be further subdivided as required.
- 5. **ADMINISTRATION**: Race headquarters for the event will be "The Rec Room" at Fay's Boat Yard, 71 Varney Point Road, Gilford, NH.
- 6. **RACING AREA**: Races will ordinarily be started on "The Broads". In the case of extreme conditions, the race committee may elect to start races southwest of Welch Island.
- 7. **COURSES**: The race committee will set "Buoy"

courses as it deems appropriate for the Racing class. Course signals will be posted on the committee boat as per the Sailing Instructions. Island courses will be set for Cruising Classes as conditions warrant.

- 9. **SKIPPERS MEETING**: Sailing Instructions and class assignments will be available at the skippers meeting on Saturday, August 21st. The Skippers Meeting will be held to reiterate information contained in the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions and to answer questions. There will be no skipper's meeting on the following Sunday race dates.
- 10. **SCORING SYSTEM**: The low-point scoring system (Appendix A4 of the racing rules) will apply. One race will constitute a regatta. Each boat's series score will be the total of all its scores, discarding the worst scores, one for every four races sailed.
- 11. **PRIZES**: First and Second Place awards will be made in all classes and Third Place Awards will be made in classes with five or more boats.
