**Entry:** Each entry must be submitted on the form attached hereto (photo and fax copies will be accepted). The entry fee is \$30.00 (\$25.00 for USSA members) by cash or check payable to Winnipesaukee Yacht Club (WYC).

**Site:** Racing will take place on Lake Winnipesaukee. Buoy racing will be on courses described by LWSA/WYC sailing instructions. Courses and classes for island racing will be determined by consensus, prior to the start of the race, to accommodate a broad range of boat types and interests.

**Contact:** Mail entries to: WYC, P.O.Box 11, Laconia, NH 03247, or hand in an application on race day.

**Prizes:** Prizes will be awarded to the top finishers in fleets of three or four boats. Prizes will be awarded to the top three finishers in fleets of five or more boats.

**Social:** Light snacks and beverages will be served after the race. There will be a charity auction, with the proceeds to benefit the Dana-Farber Cancer Institute's Jimmy Fund. An award ceremony will be held at the WYC immediately following the auction.
