## NOTICE OF RACE

## 1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (2005-2008) and the Notice of Race for the U.S. Men's Championship for the Clifford D. Mallory Trophy and the U.S. Sailing Championship Conditions except as herein modified including a completed and signed U.S. Men's Championship entry form.
- 1.2 Racing rule 70.4 will be changed as follows: the right of appeal is denied because of the time limitation required to qualify for the national finals.
- 1.3 J80 class rules will not apply.

## 2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 Each of the four sailing associations, Mass Bay, SM Sailing, Narragansett Bay and Northeast Sailing, comprising Area A will be permitted to send two crews and there shall be no more that two crews from any one sailing association with a maximum of eight crews competing.
- 2.2 A crew will consist of a skipper and three crew members.
- 2.3 US Sailing entry form properly completed is required.
- 2.4 Skippers MUST contact Bob Knowles at via bobknow@NOSPAMmetrocast.netNOSPAM (remove both NOSPAM's from the email address before sending) least 72 hours prior to the competitors meeting to verify the entry.

### 3. FEES

- 3.1. The entry fee has been paid by each sailing association to the New England Yacht Racing Council.
- 3.2 A damage deposit of \$250.00 payable to New England Yacht Racing Council (NEYRC) is the responsibility of each crew. If there is no damage at the end of the event, the damage check will be returned.
- 3.3 A borrowed boat insurance fee of \$50.00 payable to New England Yacht Racing Council (NEYRC) covers the cost of insuring the boats and is non-refundable.
- 3.4 A regatta fee of \$60.00 payable to the Lake Winnipesaukee Sailing Association, Inc. (LWSA) covers incidental cost incurred by the host.
