Date: Saturday August 30th – Sunday August 31st

Invitation: The LWSA is pleased to invite all sailors to the inaugural LWSA Labor Day Regatta. The regatta combines events on both Saturday and Sunday to provide both competitive sailing for all sized yachts and attract new sailors and their friends in a range of social activities.

Points will be awarded to competitors for both Saturday and Sunday's Races for the Regatta's "Lake Winnie Cup" Award – a LWSA perpetual trophy awarded by race sponsor Workforce Training Resources, LLC.

Eligibility: The races are open to ALL sailboats.

Rules and Scoring:

- 1. **Saturday 30th August**: two races commencing at 1:00 PM planned for the area know as "the broads" under RROS Rules: comprising a start, a course around three markers and the finish. There will be a 30 minutes time gap from when the last competing boat crosses the finish line to the start of Race 2. **Note:**
 - a. Single start all boats
 - Skippers Meeting Fays Boatyard Sailing School Classroom at 11.30 AM
 - c. Places 1st to 5th for **each race** will be awarded points on the basis of 10 points =1st, 8 points = 2nd, 6 points = 3rd, 4 points = 4th and 2 points = 5th. All other places will receive one point (1) for competing
- Sunday 31st August: a round-the-islands race commencing at 11:30, course to be advised at the Captain meeting. This race has special conditions:

- a. Boats will be given a 5 second positive concession per mile on their PHRF rating <u>for each crew</u> member over three (three)
- **b.** Boats will be given a further 5 second positive concession per mile for having a female skipper at the helm for ALL of the duration of the race.
- c. Single handed sailor/boats will be given a 5 second positive concession per mile on their PHRF rating.
- d. Scoring for Sunday's race placing will be based on the same point's method as Saturday.

Entry: The entry fee for this event is \$20 to be paid at registration – at the Skippers meeting.

Competing yachts are invited to provide a "plate of communal food/goodies/grog" to be produced at the after race function on the Main Dock at Fays Boatyard at 6.30 PM on Saturday August 30th.

Site: The starting point for the race will be determined at the Saturday August 30th – Skippers' Meeting at 11:30 AM in Fay's Boatyard /Sailing School classroom. Monitor Channel #72 for information/updates.

Prizes: Prizes will be awarded to the top three finishers for both Saturday and Sunday. The overall winner by points for both days will be awarded the Lake Winnie Cup.

Social: Awards: Following Saturdays Race a Social Function is planned for the Main Dock, Fays Boatyard stating at 6:30 PM. Following Sundays Race a Ramp-Up Party is planned, followed by Awards.
