ANNUAL DOUBLE HANDED FRYING PAN RACE

Friday, September 4, 2009

1. **RULES:** The race will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing (2009 – 2012)*, the prescriptions of US Sailing, the rules of PHRF New England, the LWSA/WYC Combined sailing instruction for the current year, and any other applicable rules.
2. **ELIGIBILITY:** Any boat over 20 feet possessing a current PHRF certificate may participate. A non-protestable temporary PHRF rating may be granted to any boat not having a current rating. Boats racing after sunset must illuminate their navigation lights in order to continue or withdraw and return to their docking location. This is a double-handed event. Boats are restricted to a Skipper and one crewmember.
3. **ENTRY & FEES:** Boats must register by submitting a completed Entry Form along with the entry fee of \$15 (\$10 for US Sailing members). Registration is at 1700 Friday, September 4, 2009 at Fay's Boat Yard.
4. **CLASSES:** Boats must register to compete in either the Racing or Cruising Division. Cruising class may not use spinnakers.
5. **RACING AREA:** The race will be started along the southerly side of Welch Island.
6. **COURSES:** The course is traditionally twice around Welch Island. The race committee may shorten the course to once around by displaying code flag S before the first boat passes the Start/Finish line.
7. **SCHEDULE:** Friday, September 4, 2009

8. **SKIPPER'S MEETING:** A Skippers Meeting will be held at Fay's Main Dock per the schedule to reiterate information contained in the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions and to answer any questions.
9. **SCORING SYSTEM:** Finishing position is determined by corrected PHRF time using the time on time scoring system.
10. **AWARDS:** The winner of each division will enjoy the distinction of having their accomplishment recorded on the perpetual "Frying Pan" trophies hanging in the Fay's Boat Yard Chandlery.

The undersigned represents that all equipment aboard, including, but not limited to, safety and emergency equipment, is properly stowed, has been well maintained, is in good operating condition and is appropriate for this competition. The undersigned also represents that he/she and any crew permitted aboard the boat are experienced and competent, are physically fit, and capable of swimming or treading water in full sailing attire, and have been instructed in the use and location of all safety equipment aboard the boat.

The undersigned acknowledges that the decision to start and/or continue racing is the sole and exclusive responsibility of the undersigned.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, the undersigned certifies that each of the foregoing statements and representations are true and accurate and, on behalf of himself/herself and his/her heirs, successors and assigns, hereby releases and forever discharges J/80 Fleet 1, Fay's Boatyard, Inc., The Winnepesaukee Yacht Club and the Lake Winnepesaukee Sailing Association, Inc. and their respective members, volunteers, employees, agents, Officers, Board of Directors, Race Committees and Juries from any and all liability arising out of my participation in this regatta and all social events connected therewith, whether such loss is due to property damage, personal injuries or loss of life, even if such loss is due to the negligence of any party so released.
